To this end, Tzion has translated the 5 books of the Torah into Luganda, the most widely read language in Uganda.

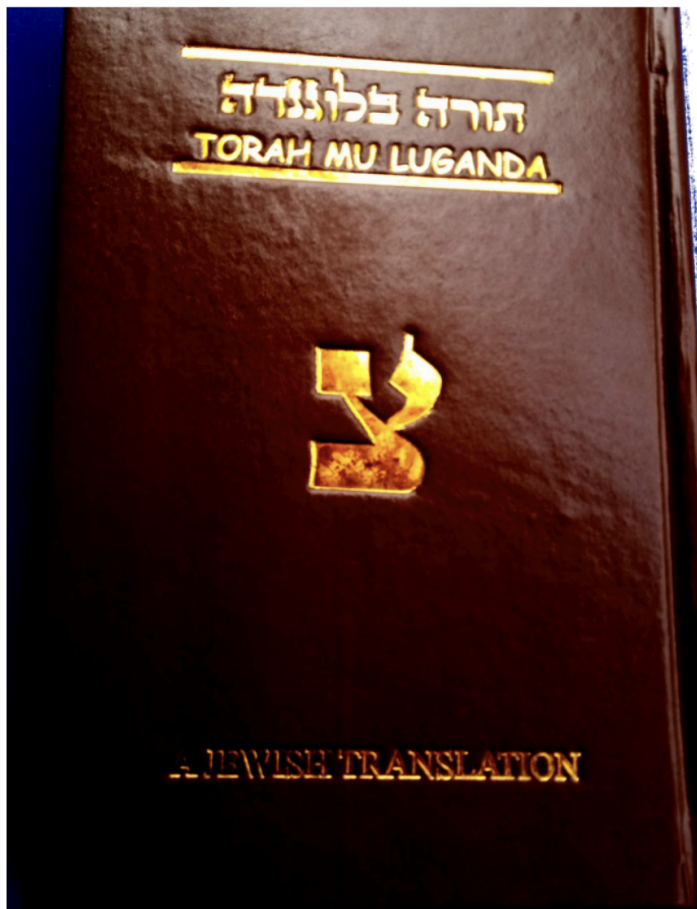
There are 12 synagogues in Uganda. Tzion dreams for each of these synagogues to have enough copies for each synagogue to host a minyan. With 10 copies of the Torah written in a locally accessible language, each Abayudaya congregation could better root themselves in their own unique Jewish context, helping their communities thrive.
